a larger size for larger dogs. We also thought it was good value."

Description and claims: This fluffy bathroom towel is made from microfibre and is excellent at soaking up water — apparently seven times more than an ordinary towel. When damp, it can be used on dusty dogs as the fibres attract and cling on to dirt. Machine washable.
